Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 17th day of March 1769 for Capt. Kerns being the Allotment which fell to him in the Division of a tract of 1105 Acres Surveyed for the Officers of Col. T. Francis Corps in pursuance of an order of Survey dated the 9th day of March 1769 And now Owned and Occupied by Thomas Howard in right of the said Capt. Kerns.
