



Situate in White Deer Township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 4th day of November A.D. 1833 by virtue of an Application dated the 3d day of April 1769 N^o 2034 granted to Lawrence Miller containing one hundred & sixty seven Acres with the Usual Allowance of six per Cent. &c.

Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 10th day of September 1773 for William Duncan in pursuance of his order of Survey dated the 3d day of April 1769 N^o 295 And now owned and Occupied by Aaron Chamberlin in right of the said William Duncan.
