



Situate in Turbut township Northumberland County on a stream leading into the N.E. side of W. branch of the Susquehanna surveyed on the 24th day of October A.D. 1835 by virtue of an order dated the 3rd day of April 1769^{N° 2044} granted to Hannah Wilson containing Three hundred acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note the same tract of land was surveyed on the — day of — 17 — for James Watts in pursuance of his order dated the 3rd day of April 1769¹⁰⁶⁹ and is now owned and occupied by the heirs of Joseph Gaston in right of said James Watts.
