Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 7th day of September 1832 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to James McMullen dated the 3^d day of April 1769 No 2426 containing one hundred & three acres & sixty five perches with the usual allowance &c.

Note - The same being part of a tract of land surveyed the 3^d day of August 1769 for Joseph Hudnot by virtue of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 No 1856. And now owned & occupied by Fanny Derr & her children - heirs of George Derr Dec^d in right of said Joseph Hudnot.
