Report - The above land is entirely the same which was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Mary Evans for 50^{ac} dated the 16th November 1774 and Patented to Samuel Fullerton the 3rd October 1809. - Now owned and occupied by John Fife.

There is no evidence of John Hall having ever been in possession.
