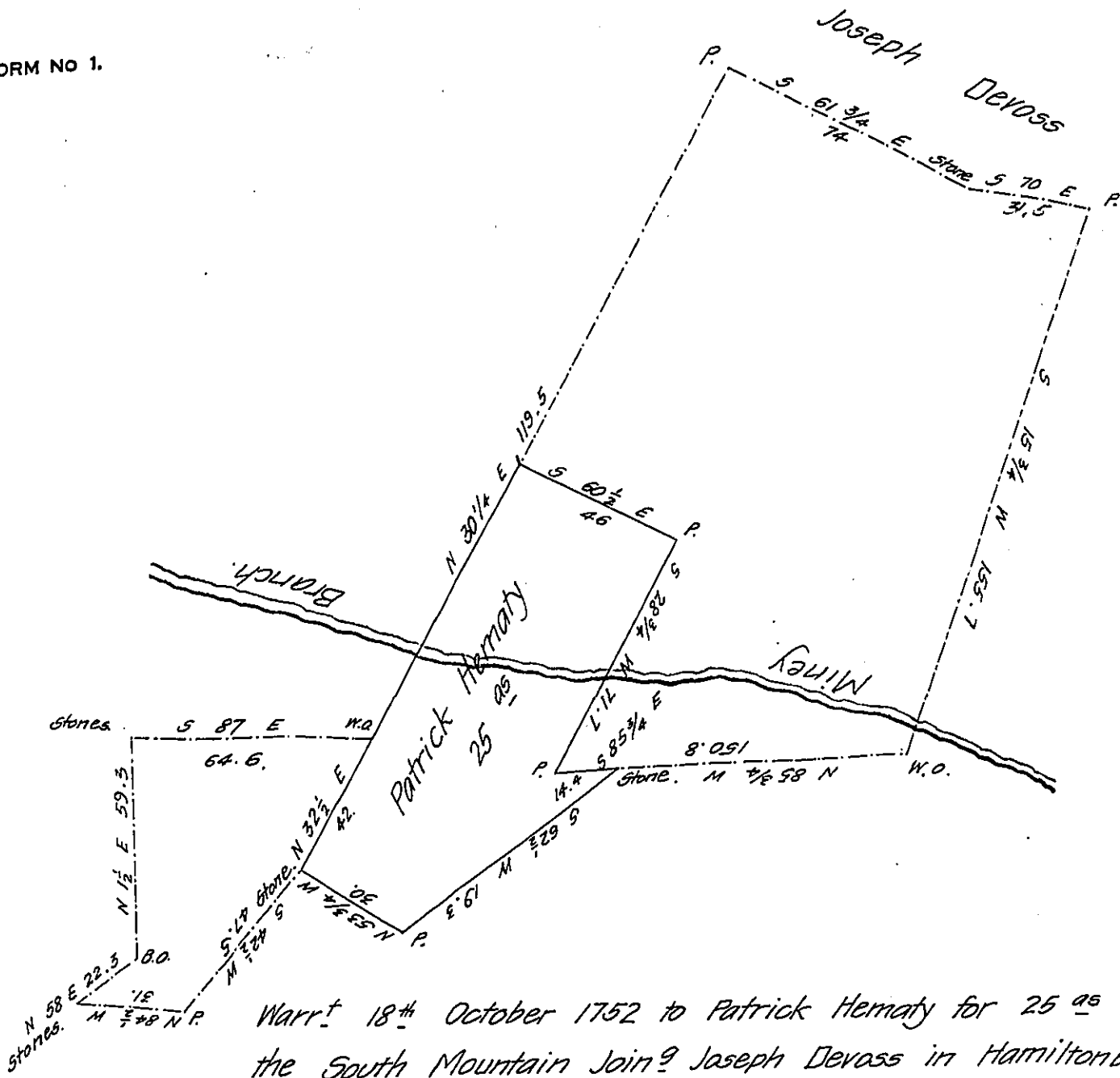

Warrant 18<sup>th</sup> October 1752 to Patrick Hematy for 25<sup>as</sup> in the South Mountain Join? Joseph Devoss in Hamiltonban Township.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 18<sup>th</sup> October 1752 to Patrick Hematy for 25<sup>as</sup> in the South Mountain in Hamiltonban Township, as above specified on Lands situate as aforesaid in Hamiltonban Township & have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
