



Situate in Paradise township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 156^a 80 perches and the usual allowance &c. Located on the 6th day of October 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Philip Myer for 40^a dated the 18th day of December 1751 & by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report - The above is wholly the same Land which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Matthias Brindle dated the 8 day of January 1770 and is now owned and occupied by Henry King. It is not known that Meyers ever was in possession.
