 Situate in Codorus township in the County of York. That part within the black lines containing 100<sup>as</sup> 94<sup>as</sup> and the allowance &c was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Anthony Moul for 50<sup>a</sup> dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1751. The part of the same within the red lines containing about 42<sup>as</sup> &c<sup>a</sup> was surveyed and said to be returned and Patented on a Warrant granted to William Scott for 40<sup>as</sup> dated the 12<sup>th</sup> June 1788 and the part within the yellow lines embraced within a survey (as represented by the Dotted Lines) made and held under a Maryland Patent granted to Andrew Hershey. The whole tract owned and in possession of John Martin & Jacob Hershey in Paradise town<sup>p</sup>. - Moul's Warrant said to be abandoned - Reported &c 18<sup>th</sup> November 1828
