



Warrant granted 1st April 1751 to John Mann for 30⁰⁵ joining lands late of Robert Park & Robert Mc Comaughy in Menallen.—

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 1st April 1751 to John Mann for 30⁰⁵ joining as above specified on Lands situate as aforesaid in Menallen Township and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram—
