



Warrant 10th Septem^r 1750 to Archibald Mahon for 50 a^s on a branch of Bermudian Creek in Huntingdon Town^{sh}.

The Part marked A is an Interference of a Tract of 333 a^s Surveyed on Warr^t to Henry Harris dated March 18th 174⁶/₇, the whole Tract now owned by David Peters, Thomas Stephens, & Dan^l Fickes - situate in Huntingdon Township.

Part B. is an Interference of a Tract of 178 a^s surveyed on Warr^t to Richard Proctor dated April 25th 1747, situate in Huntingdon Township. Now owned by Henry Bittinger, John How, David Demaree & John Sadler jr. Witness my hand
