



The Part marked A is an Interference of a Tract of 76^{ac} 114^{ps} Patented to Philip Hollabaugh 3^d October 1810 - now owned and possessed by John Hemler - (See return of Adam Gramlich.)

The Part marked B containing 17^{ac} & 120^{ps} & all^{cs} now owned by John & William Hollabaugh is not yet patented - situate in Mount-pleasant Township Adams County. Witness my hand August 16th 1837
