of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons hold-
ing Lands by virtue of locations or other Office Titles issued from or under
the Proprietary Government & for other Purposes I have this day surveyed
and located Warrant granted to William Nash for 60^{as} including his Imp^t
dated 19th July 1762, in Huntingdon Township on Lands situate as afore-
said, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed
Diagram - Witness my hand
