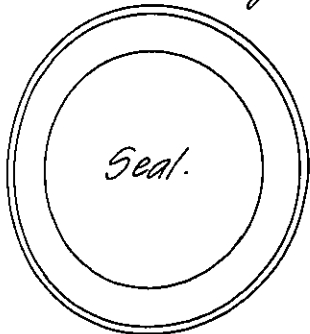


Pensylvania fo.*By the Commissioners of Property.*

At the request of Vincent Cadwell that we would grant him to take up three hundred and Seventy five acres of Land in this Province Purchased of the Proprietor by John Kennerly and by him convey'd to Constantine Overtorn in whose right the said Land is to be Survey'd. These are to authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the said Vincent in the right aforesaid the said quantity of three hundred and seventy five Acres of Land (according to the method of Townships appointed that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by ye Secretary. Given under our Hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 8th of the 3^d Moth 1706
