 and fifty Akers as head right for James Croft Mary his wife and Hesther  
 theyr daughter and joyne it to Joseph Knights Hundred Akers on the  
 backe side of thomas Paschalls Lands neare unto Skoolekill River <sup>in a reasonable long square)</sup> so as  
 more heade Rights may with Conveniency be added thereto and returne to  
 me a true duplicate of ye field worke and protracted figure which is  
 to remaine in my office dated 14<sup>th</sup> of 7<sup>mo</sup>: 82
