



The Part marked A is an Interference of a tract of 31^{ac} 128^{ac} & all^{ac} for a long time in dispute but eventually patented by T. & R. Penn to Nicholas Meyer & John Pecker by Patent dated 9th June 1768 in pursuance of Appⁿ N^o 3616 dated 8th May 1767 & surveyed 4th day of August 1767.

The Part marked B is an Interference of said John Wagner's (or Hans U. Waggoner's) other land being a tract of 254^{ac} & 135^{ac} & all^{ac} Surveyed on warrant dated 13th Sept 1743 and patented to Michael Hoffman 3^d Sept 1809 - enrolled in Pat. Book H. Vol. 1st page 437 - Now situate in Reading Township Adams County owned and possessed by Doct: Thomas Stephens
