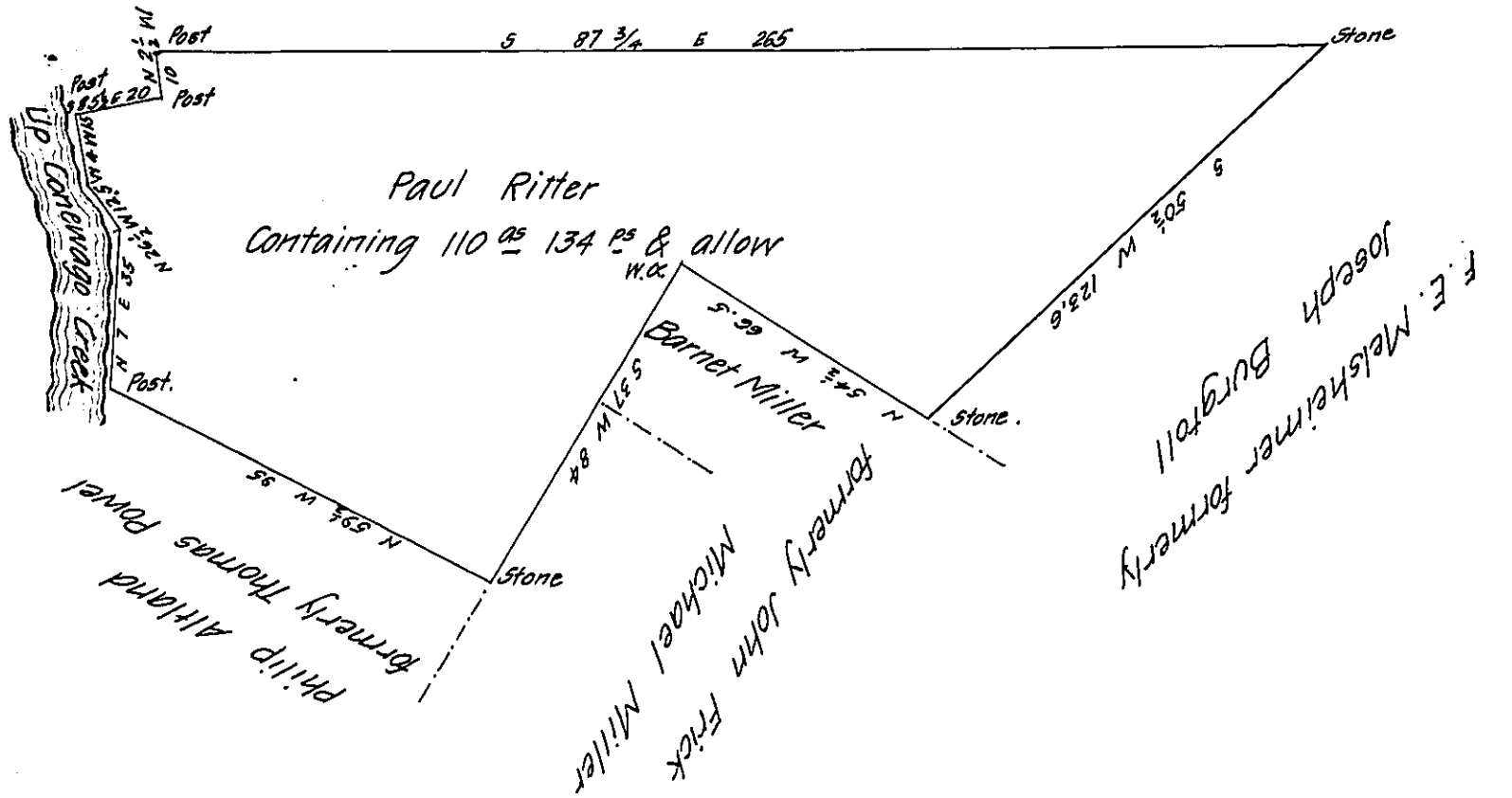


Formerly Thomas Petit
