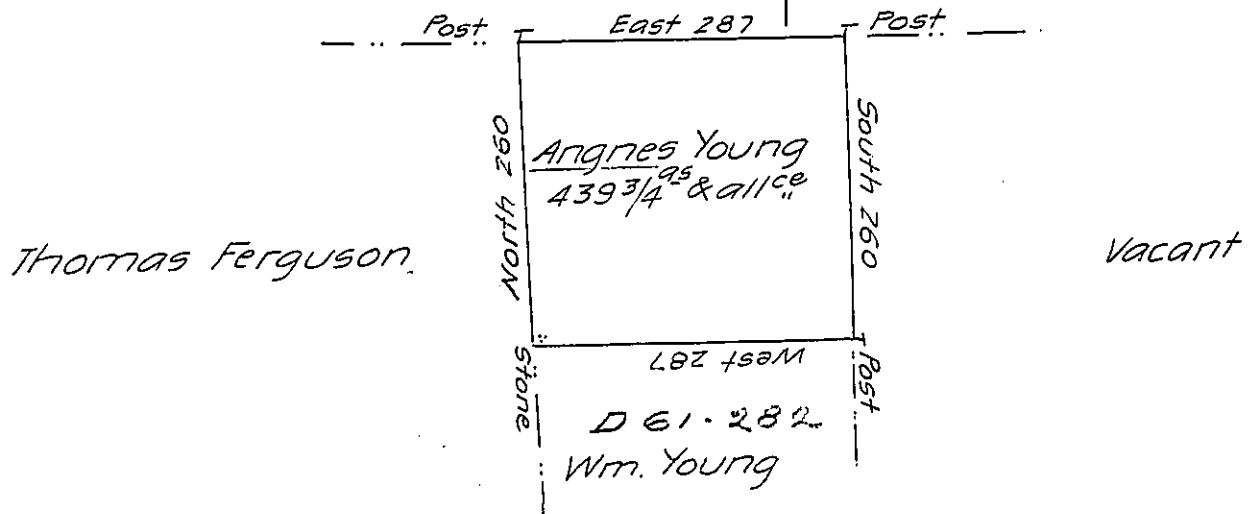

The above is a draught of a Tract of Land called Cranbrook Surveyed the 24th Septem<sup>r</sup>. 1789 in pursuance of a warrant to Agnes Young ~~dated the sixteenth day of <sup>December</sup> to Agnes Young~~ dated the sixteenth day of december in the year one thousand seven hundred seven hundred and eighty <sup>eight</sup> ~~five~~. Situate on the waters of Wheeling Creek adjoining land of William Young in Washington County Containing four hundred and thirty nine acres and three quarters of an acre with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
