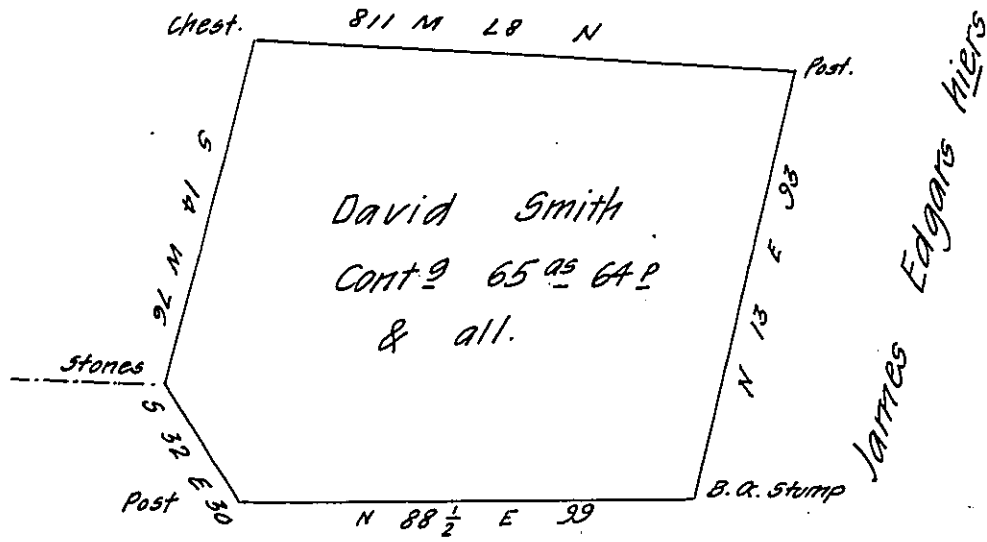


James Johnson Esq.
