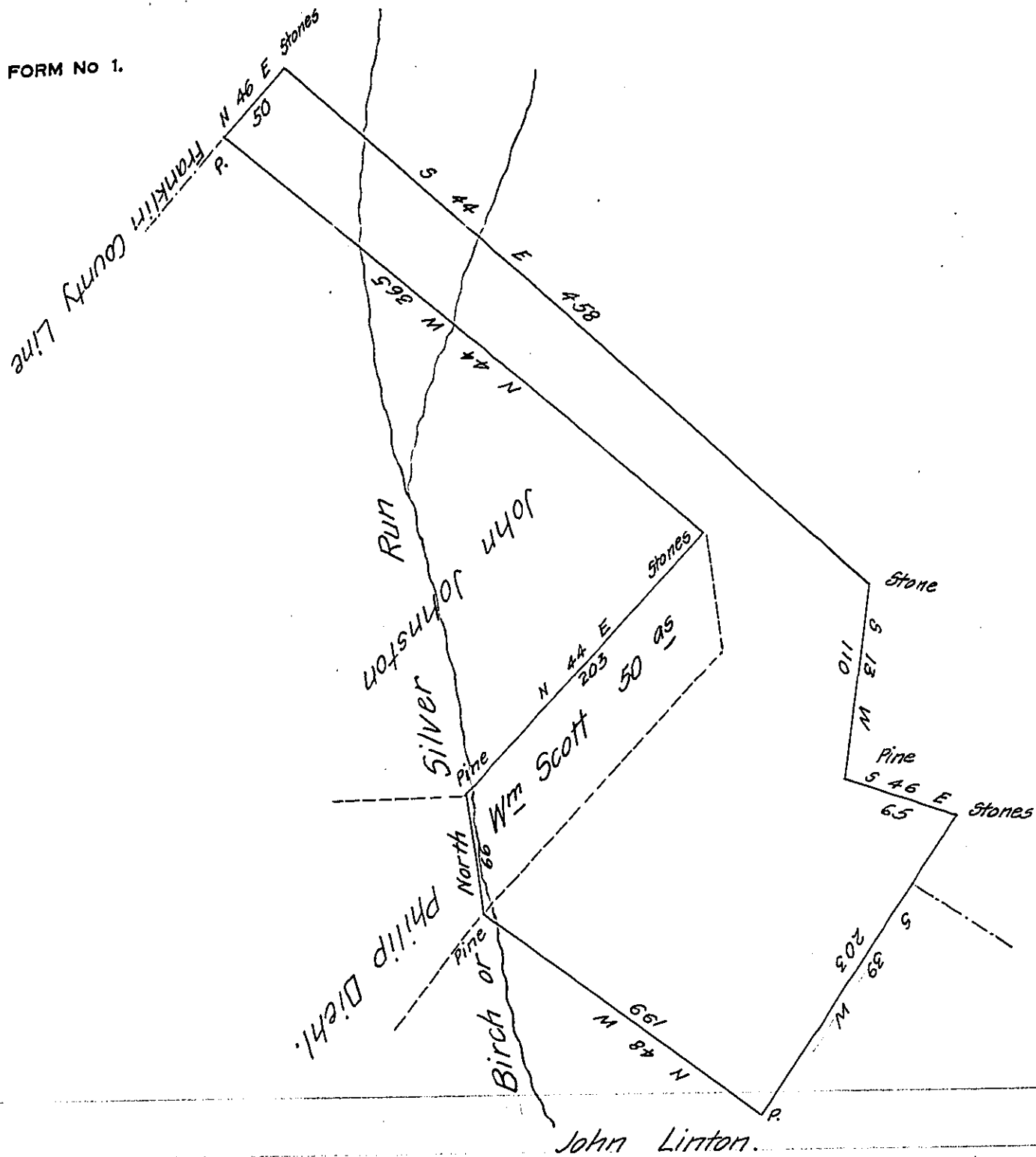

Warrant dated 19<sup>th</sup> July 1762 to William Scott for 50<sup>as</sup> on the Mountain on Silver Run.

The whole of the above Tract is an Interference of a Tract of 444<sup>as</sup> & all<sup>ce</sup>. Surveyed on Warrant to James Brotherton dated 24<sup>th</sup> March 1794 - Situate in Franklin Town<sup>p</sup> Adams County now owned by James Brotherton - Witness my hand

October 11<sup>th</sup> 1838 Jm<sup>o</sup> L. Gubernator -

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty ninth day of October 1908
