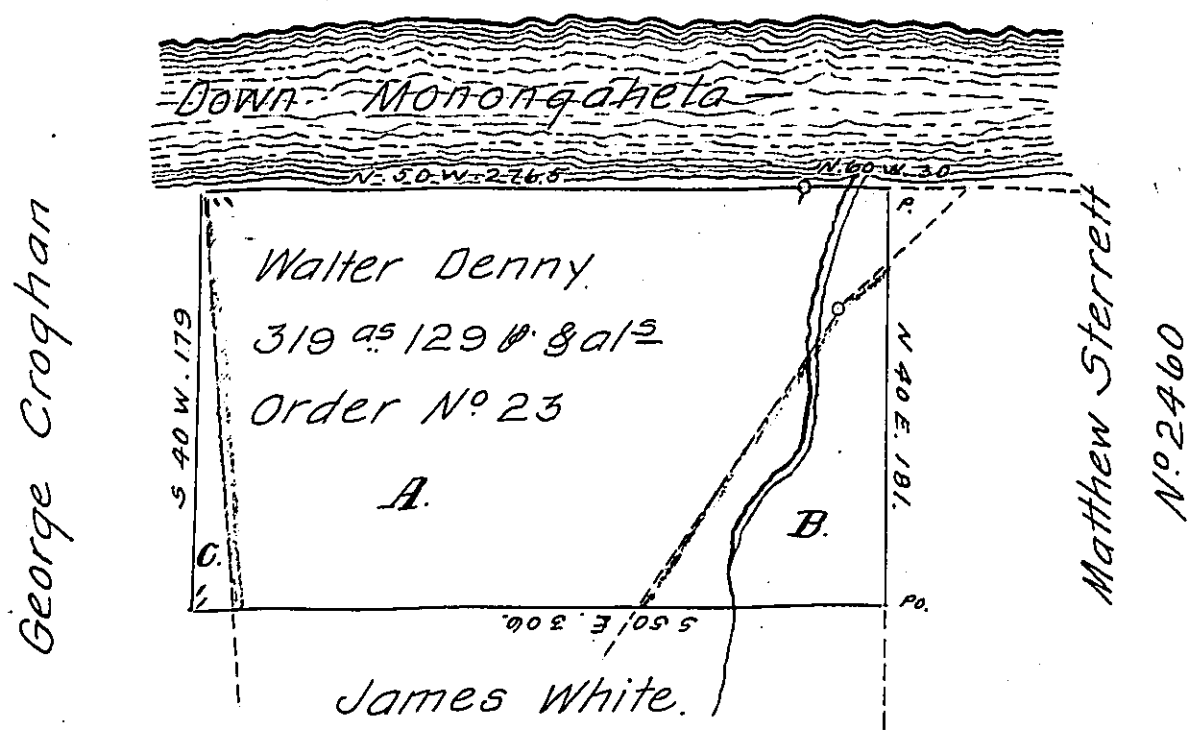

In pursuance of a Contract of the first of November 1827. with the Members of the Board of property of the State of Pennsylvania & the Authority therein stated. the above tract of Land was Surveyed & Calculated by Virtue of Application No 23. Granted to Walter Denny. Ap^l 3^d 1769. by the proprietary Government. Containin- three Hundred & Nineteen Acres, one hundred & twenty nine perches & Allowance of Six p^{ct} situate In Wilkins Township Allegheny County. Including part of Gen^l Braddocks Battle ground.

N.B. The above Survey is designated by letters as follows. **A.** Represents an Interference of a Survey ~~of~~ belonging to the Pitt^s Bank in right of the heirs of George Wallace. title obtained from Rob^t. Thompson.

B. Interferes with the Survey of George Wallace in right of Peter Raleto. now the property of the Pitt^s Bank.

C. Interferes with survey of Geo. Wallace in right of John Frazer now the property of Pitt^s Bank.
