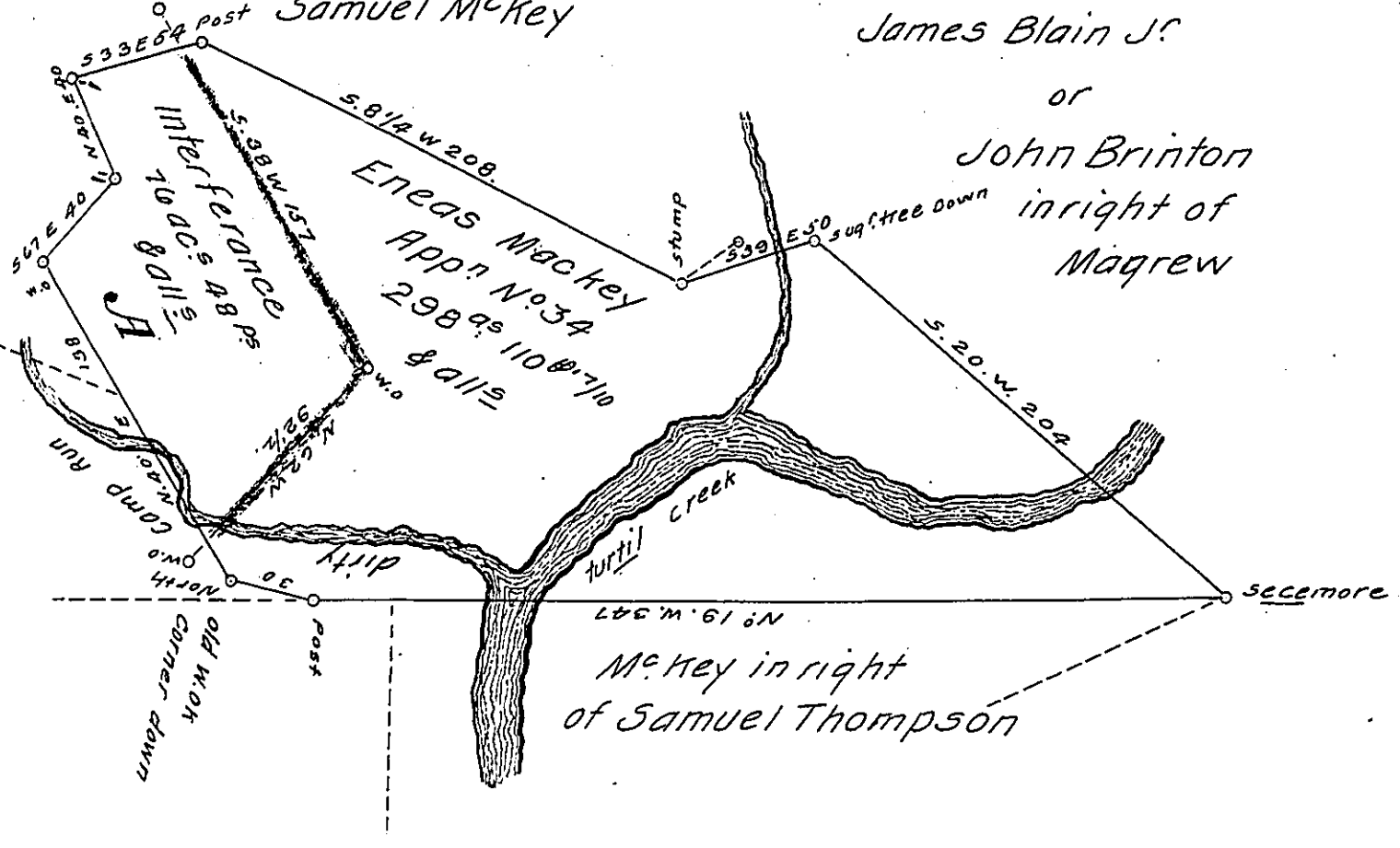

Pursuant to Contract of the first of Nov^r 1827 with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylvania, and the authority therein, the above Tract of Land bordered with gamboge, was surveyed and Calculated, by virtue of Application N^o 34, granted by The Proprietary Government To Eneas Mackey, dated the first day of Ap^r 1769. Containing Two hundred Ninety Eight Acres, one hundred ten perches ⁷/₁₀ of a p^r and allowance of Six ⁸/₁₀ c^t Situated in Plum^b Township, Allegheny County, known by the name of dirty Camp Farm.
