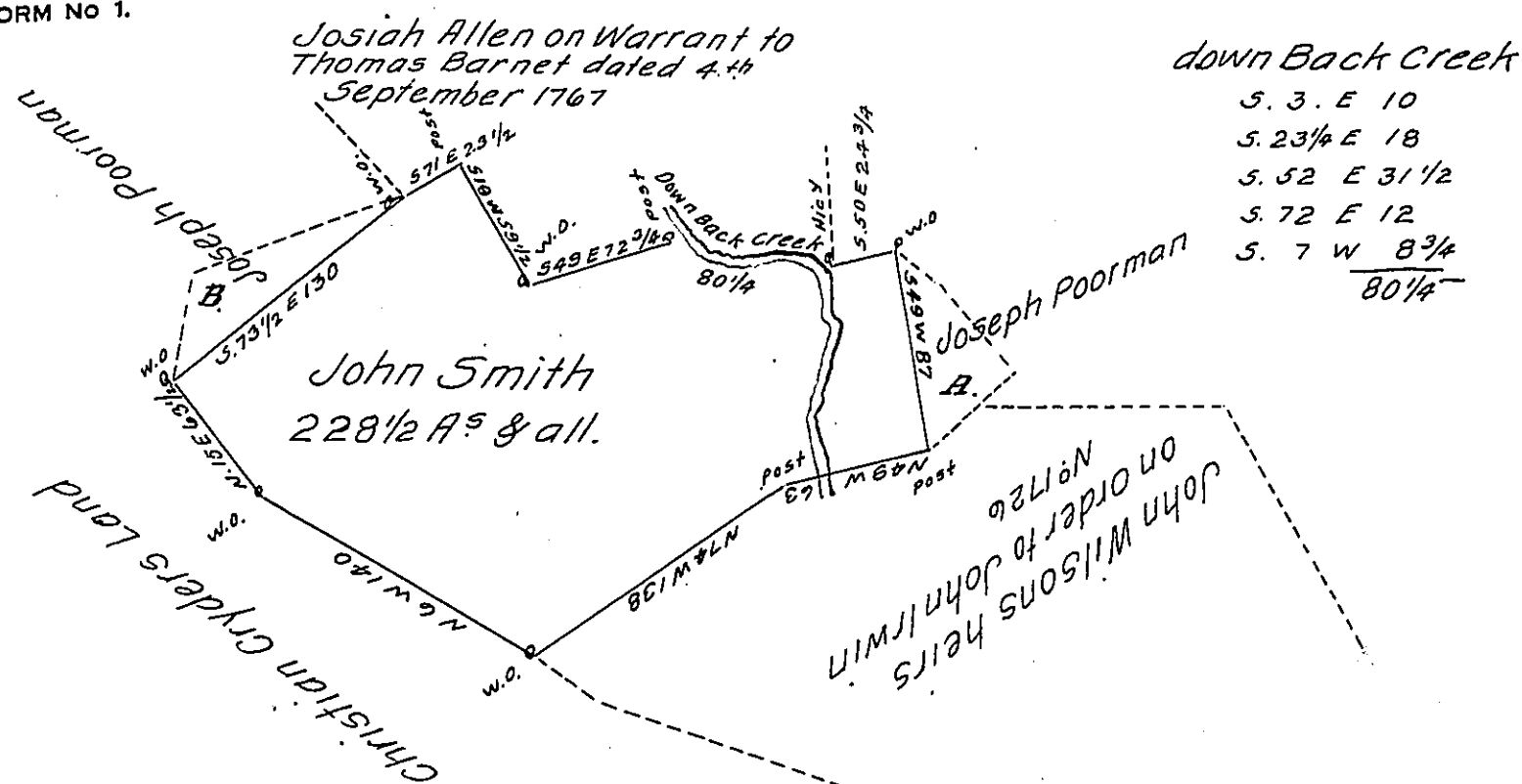

Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> September 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the Several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented Lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of a Warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> August 1744 Granted to John Smith for 200<sup>a</sup>. In Antrim Township joining Land of Thomas Barnet. Resurveyed agreeable to the old lines Surveyed by Tho<sup>s</sup> Cookson for John Smith in 1744.

Report. The above Tract is wholly embraced in a larger Tract purporting to be 264 Acres. Surveyed 18 Feb<sup>r</sup> 1761 on Warrant to George Reynolds dated 25 March 1748 held and claimed under said Title. Note the small Figures marked A & B. represent the balance of Survey on Reynolds Warrant - Note further George Reynolds being the Owner of the Tract lying South of the above Tract. in an early day. It is probable that his Warrant was taken for the same. but shifted to the Tract above Surveyed & the Tract below afterwards Surveyed on an Order to John Erwin No 1726.
