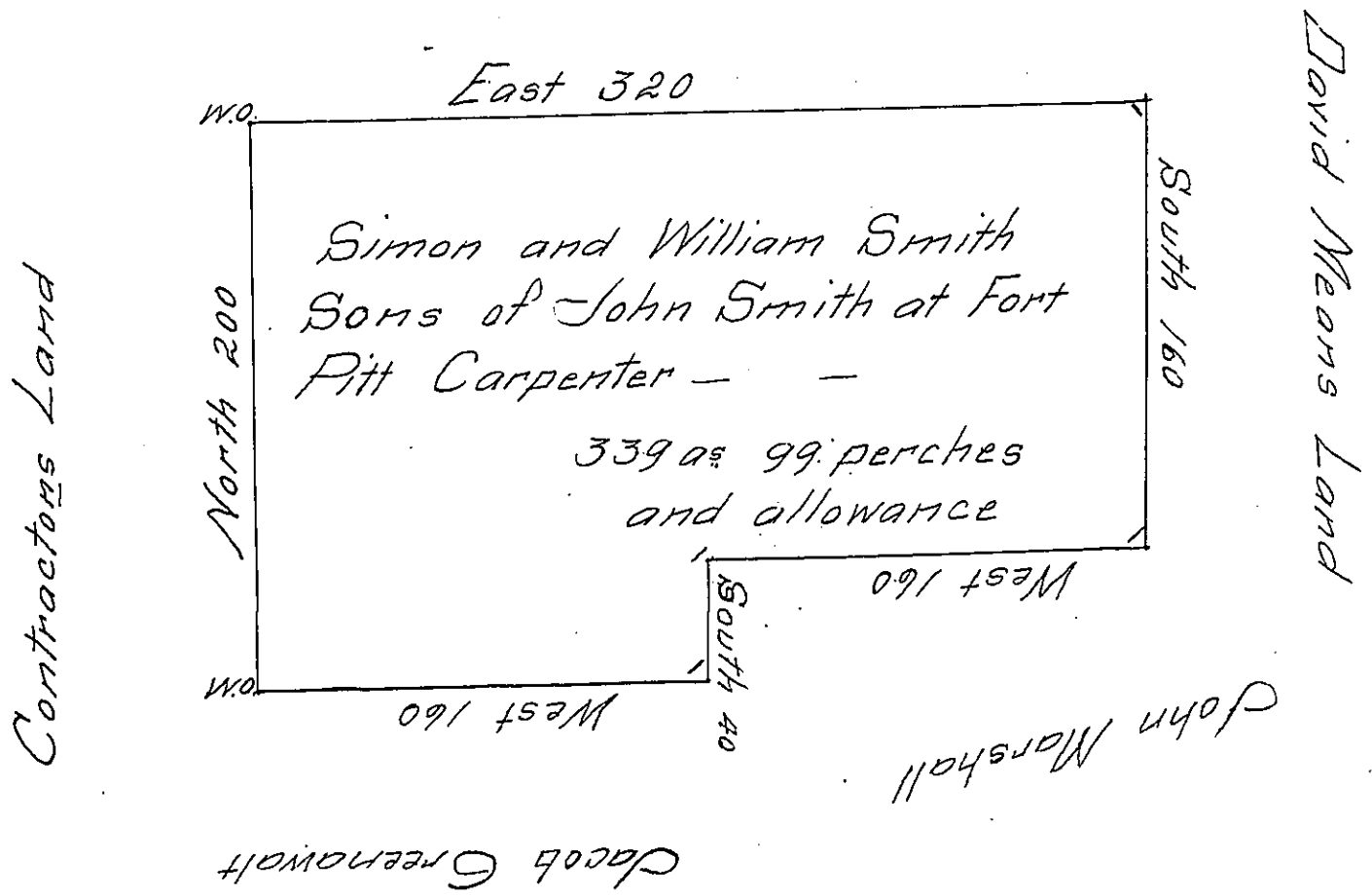


Samuel Mais

Situate near the mouth of Little Sewickly about twenty five Miles East of Fort Pitt in North Huntington township in the County of Westmoreland
