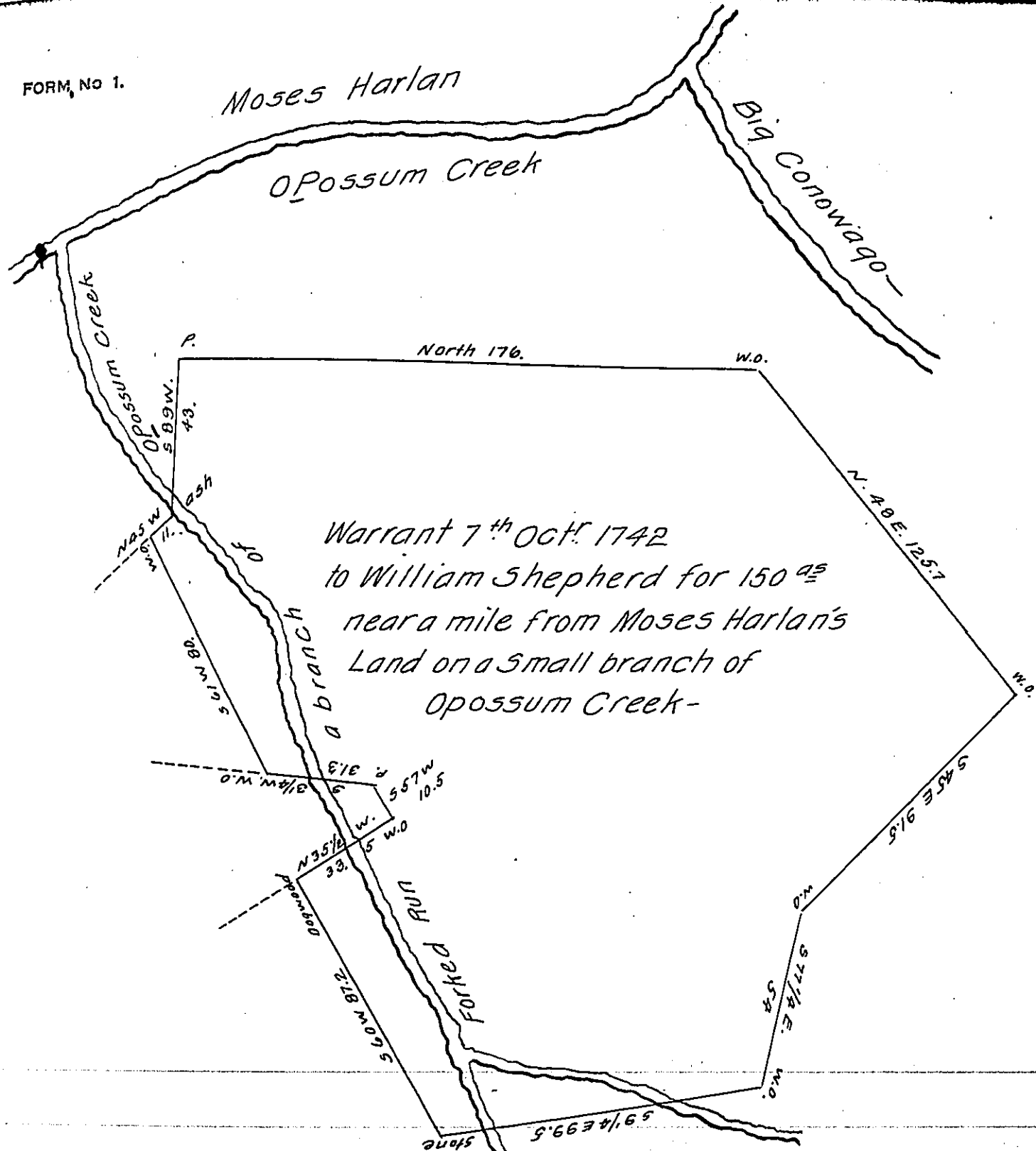

In pursuance of the Several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government & for other Purposes. I have this day located & surveyed Warrant granted 7th Oct: 1742. to William Shepherd for 150^{ac} on a small branch of Opossum Creek as above specified. on Lands situate as aforesaid. and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram - Witness my hand -
