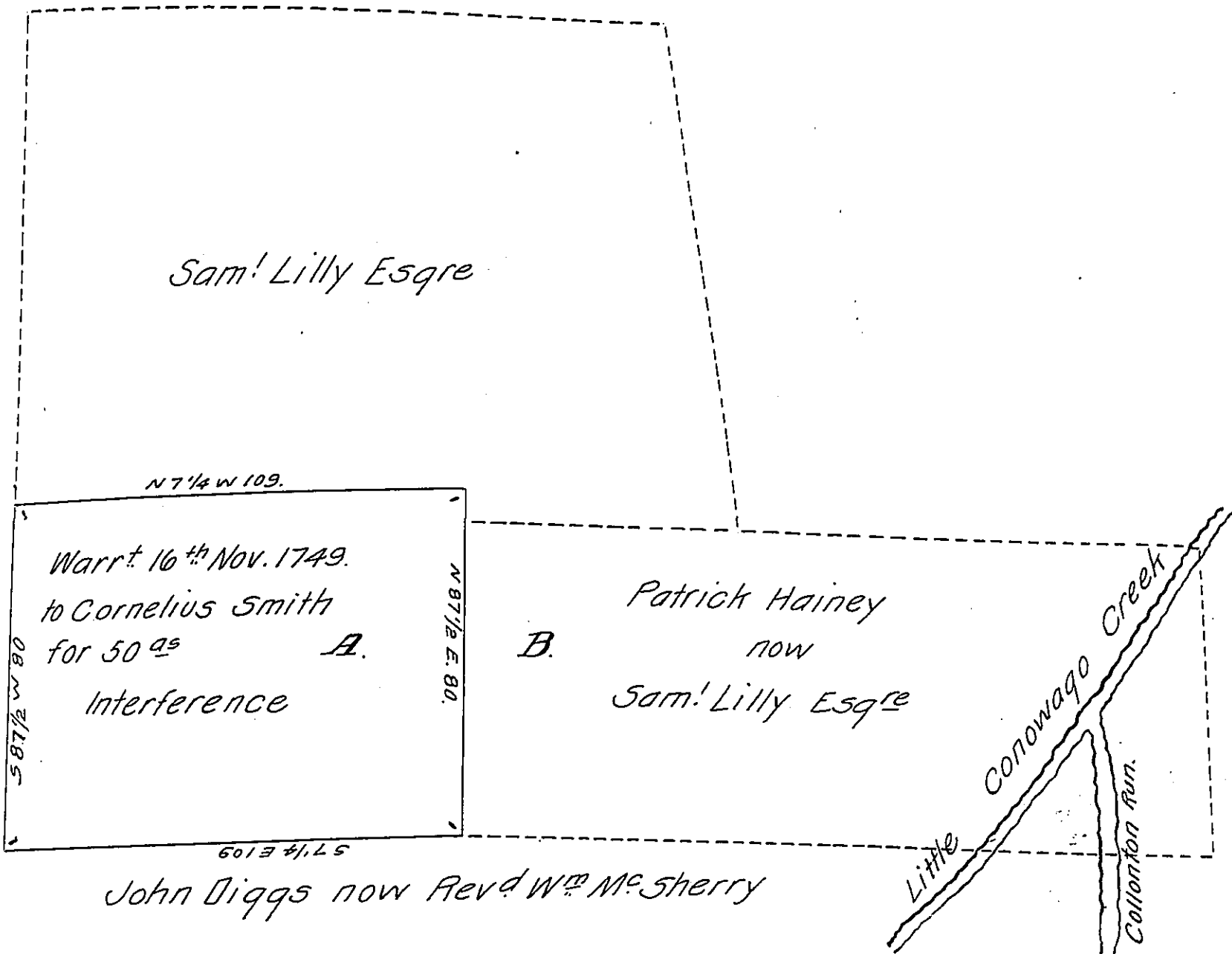

The Part marked *A.* is an Interference of a Tract of 157<sup>as</sup> & all<sup>ce</sup> surveyed and Patented to Sam! Lilly on Warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October 1754. Surveyed 7<sup>th</sup> Sept 1755 - now owned and possessed by Sam! Lilly Esq<sup>re</sup> in Mount pleasant Township Adams County.

Part *B.* is the Tract of Patrick Hainey Conveyed to Sam! Lilly by Patrick Hainey & wife by Deed dated 6<sup>th</sup> Sept 1751 -
