



In pursuance of the Several Acts of Assembly directing the Recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes. I have this day located and Surveyed Warrant issued 18th May 1742 to John Siegrist for 100 acres of Land at a place Called Round hill, on Lands so situated formerly in Berwick now Hamilton Township Adams County, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram - Witness my hand -
