Surveyed the - day of February 1769. for Capt Hendrecks. being the allotment which fell to him on the division of 8000 Acres Surveyed for the Officers of Col. F. Turbut Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey N^o 1. And now Owned By Abraham Aurand & John Hubler in right of the said Capt Hendrecks.
