



Situate in West Buffalo township Union County. Surveyed the 2^d day of May 1834 by Virtue of an Order Dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 2514 granted to Robert McKnight. Containing two Hundred & forty eight Acres & forty perches. With the Usual allowance of Six pr. Cent &c.

Note. The ^{same} tract of land was Surveyed to Ensign McMeen the same day of February 1769 being the allotment which fell to him on the Division of 8000 Acres Surveyed for the officers of Col. T. Francis Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey N^o 1. And Now owned & occupied by the heirs of Elias Youngman Decd & others in right of the said Ensign McMeens
