



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to William McAllister dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 1800. Containing two hundred and Sixteen Acres & one half with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the day of 1769 for John Potter in pursuance of his Order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N— And now Owned by Doc. Ard of Lewistown Mifflin County in right of the said John Potter.
