



Situate on the West Branch of the Susquehanna River at the Mouth of White Flint Creek in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 9th day of August A.D. 1838. by Virtue of an Order dated the 3^d of April 1769. N^o 2713 Granted to William Neil. Containing two Hundred & Ninety nine Acres and forty perches & the Usual Allowance &c. and is represented by the Green lines.

Note. the same land enterferes & is included in two Surveys made for Charles Iredell & Margaret Blyth the day of -1769 in pursuance of their Orders dated the 3^d of April 1769 & N^o 594 & 1025 and is now owned by the heirs of Dan. Callwell. Decd & others in right of the said Iredell & Blyth & is represented by the Dotted lines
