



Situate in Hartley township Union County. Surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of September 1834. by Virtue of an Order granted to William Ewings dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. No 2521. Containing two Hundred & twelve Acres & fifty three perches & the Usual allowance &c. & is Designated by the Yellow lines.

Note. The same tract of land interferes & is included <sup>in</sup> a survey Made the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November 1769. for John Templeton in pursu-  
ance of his Order Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769, <sup>No 1472</sup> & is Designated by the green lines, and is now owned by John Rays nor & others in right of the said John Templeton.
