



Situate in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 11th day of September A. D. 1832. By Virtue of an Order of Survey to Francis Wallace Dated the 3^d day of April 1769. and Numbered 2727. Containing three Hundred Acres and eighty five perches and the Usual allowance &c.

Note. the same is part of a tract of land that was surveyed the 23^d day of October 1769 for Jacob ^{Rees} in pursuance of his order of Survey Dated the third day of April 1769. & Numbered 867. and now owned & in possession of John Rank, Jacob Stahle and Joseph Dursham.
