



Situate in Buffalo township Union County. Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1833 by virtue of an order to Jacob Carter dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2552. Containing two Hundred & Seventy two Acres & one hundred & fifty perches with the usual allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1770 for John Umstead in pursuance of his order Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769 & N<sup>o</sup> 1255 and now owned & occupied by David Heinly & William Robison in right of the said John Umstead.
