or cause to be surveyd unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye
afore mentioned County & Place, provided it be not taken up
according to ye method of Townships appointed by me &
make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at
Philadelphia, ye 22^d of ye 10th mo. 1683.
