



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other office Titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 11th May 1743 to Joshua Kenworthy for 100 acres on Bermudian Creek, joining William Wyerman's Land, on Lands situate as aforesaid in Huntingdon Township Adams County, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. ~ Witness my hand. ~

December 7th 1837. *Jn^o L. Gubernator.*
