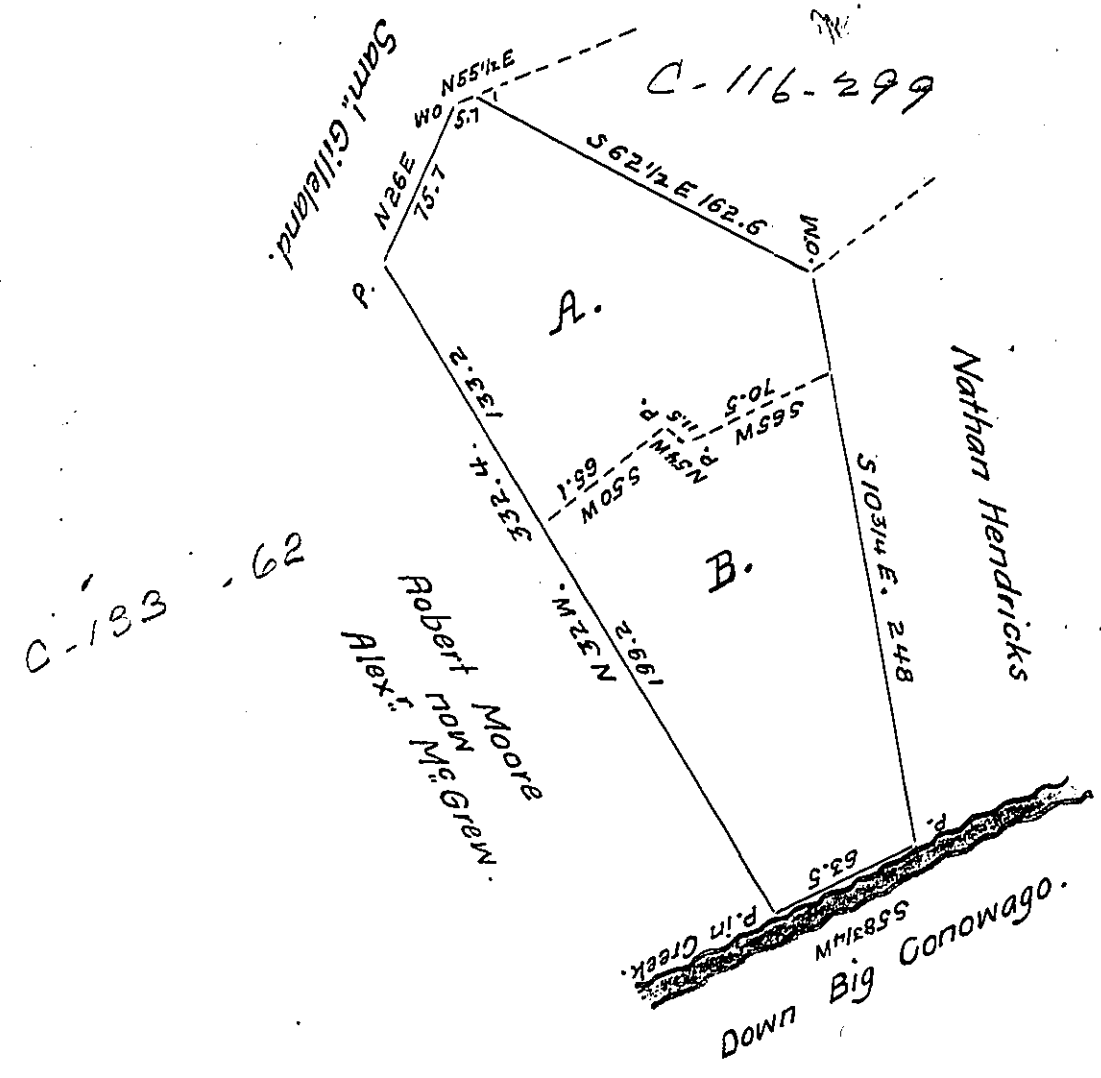

Adams County ~ Part A. Cont<sup>g</sup>. 110<sup>acs</sup> 97<sup>ps</sup> & all<sup>cs</sup> Now owned by Sam'l Mickle ~ Part B. Cont<sup>g</sup>. 121<sup>acs</sup> 55<sup>ps</sup> & all<sup>cs</sup> now owned by Jacob Mails. ~ Witness my hand. ~
