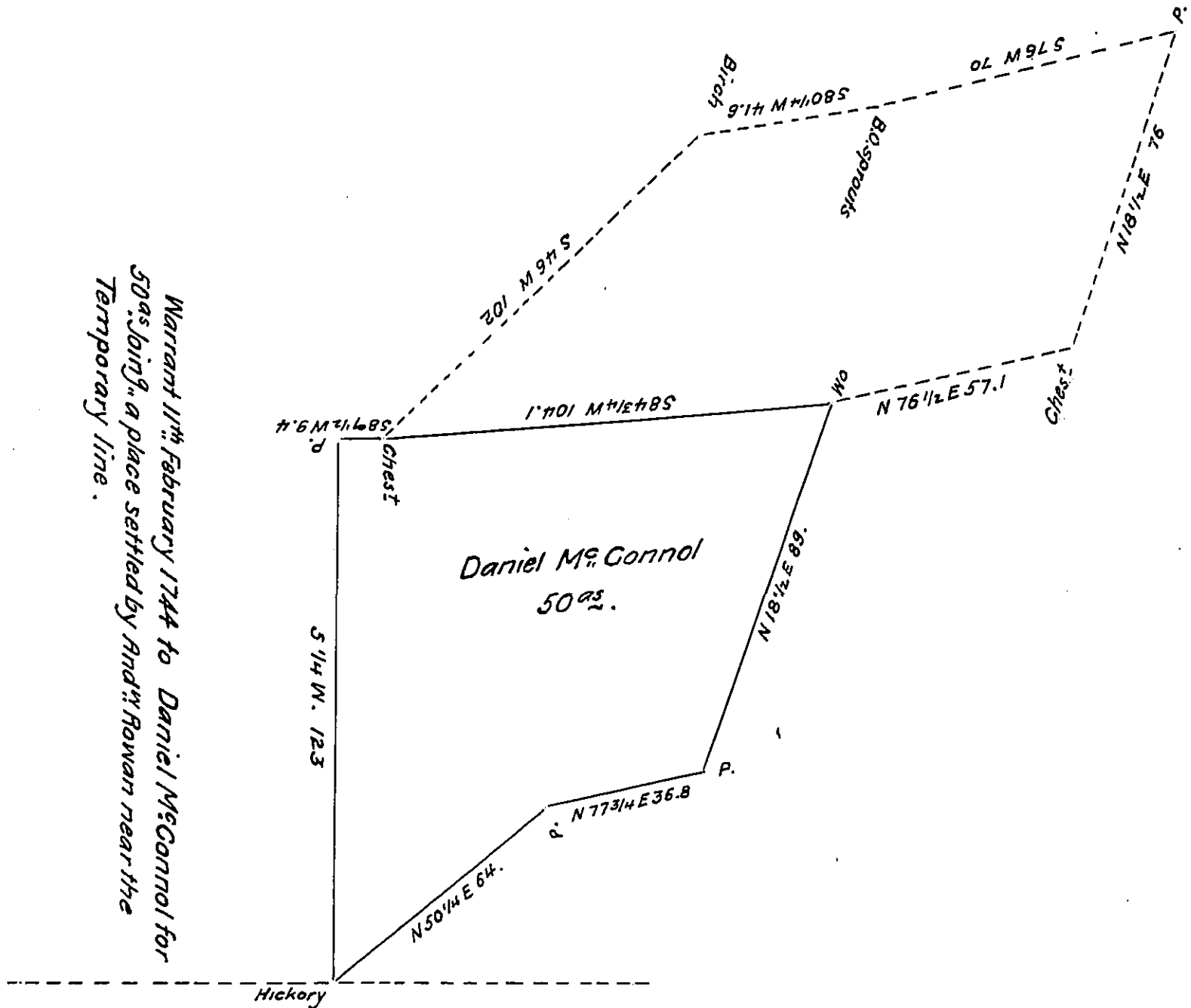


Warrant 11<sup>th</sup> February 1744 to Daniel McConnol for 50<sup>as</sup> being a place settled by And<sup>r</sup> Rowan near the Temporary line.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes, I have this day located & Surveyed Warrant granted 11<sup>th</sup> February 1744 to Daniel McConnell for 50<sup>as</sup> as above specified, on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram. Witness my hand

October 29<sup>th</sup> 1838 Jn<sup>o</sup> L. Gubernator
