



Situate in Penns township Union (late Northumberland) County Surveyed the 21st day of November 1832 by Virtue of a Warrant granted to John Hepler dated the 28th day of October 1773 Containing two hundred & Sixty four Acres & three tenths with the Usual allowance &c

Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 19th day of November 1773 for Peter Burn in pursuance of his ~~Warrant~~ order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 2175: And after a tedious lawsuit Peter Burn recovered & held the 5^d tract of land from Michael Hepler the claimant ~ And now owned & occupied by the heirs of Peter Burns & the heirs of Simon Snyder Esq dec^d in right of the said Peter Burn.
