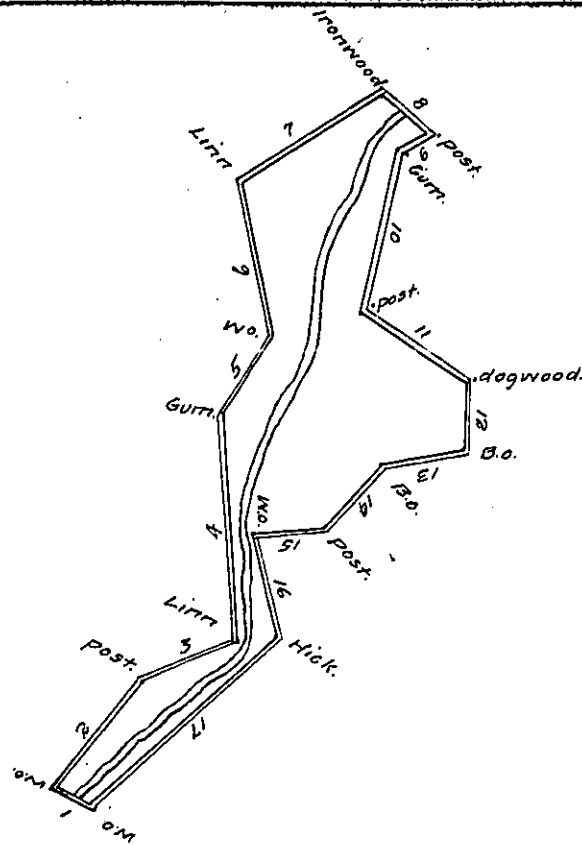

The lake colored lines represent the draught of a tract of land surveyed for Bethual Govalt on warrant dated the 12th day of March 1793 This tract interferes sixty eight acres and eighty perches with the John Holerman conveyed to Alexander McConnell, who conveyed to Nathaniel Rulow, who conveyed to Bethual Govalt who obtained the aforesaid warrant and devised the same to Isaac Govalt the present owner.
