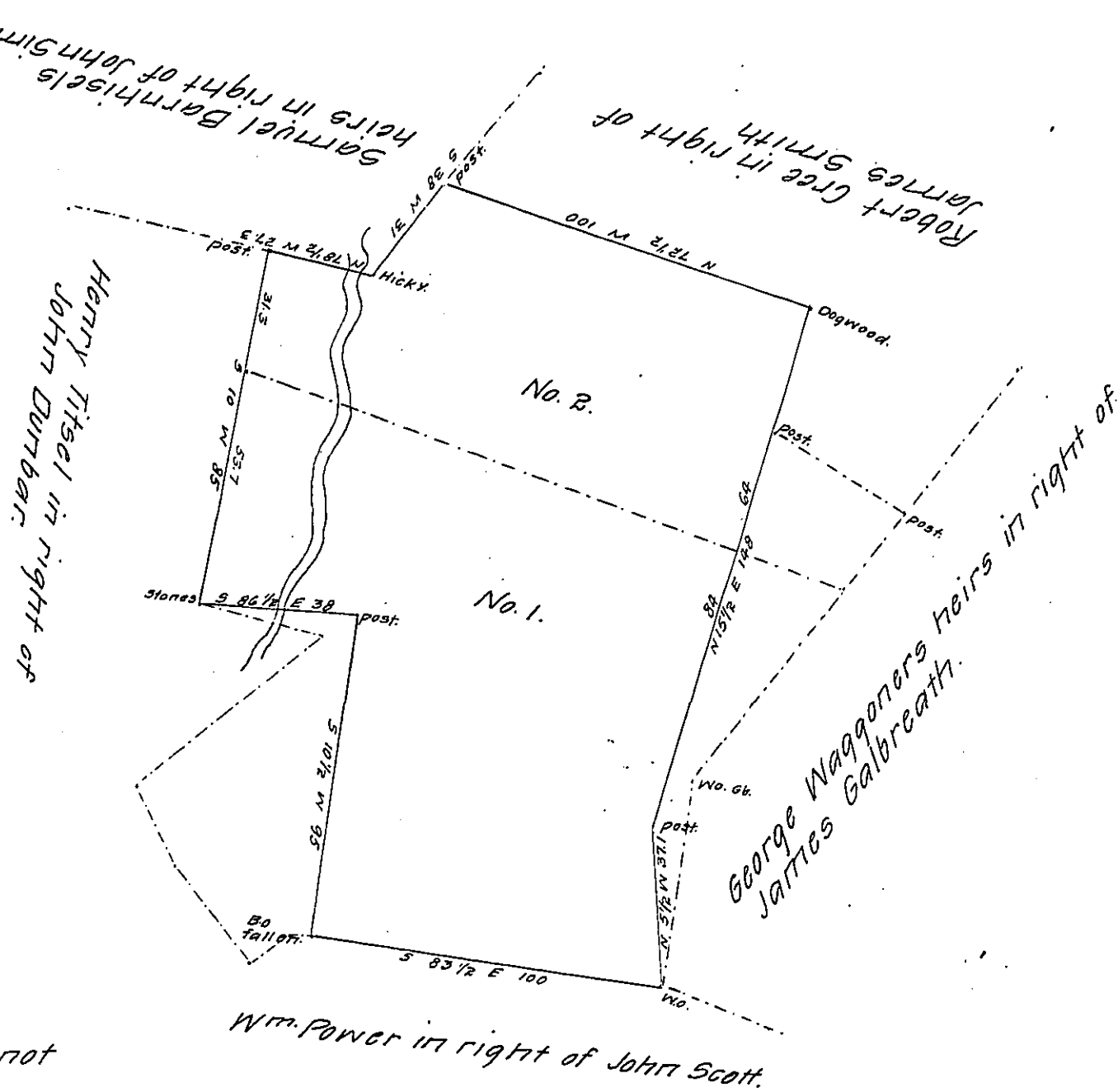

No. 2 Contains 45^{ac} 145^P & allowance part of 50^{ac} 150^P Surveyed April the 18th 1792 on warrant to Archibald Stewart dated March the 15th 1790. Containing together within the black lines 128^{ac} 71^P and owned by Samuel Stewart and Thomas Milligan the latter owning 30^{ac}
