



In pursuance of a warrant granted to Thos Lambert Byles dated 7<sup>th</sup> of April 1774 surveyed on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February 1828 the above described tract of land containing three hundred and twenty one acres one hundred and thirty seven perches and the allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c. Situate on the North branch of Shirtees creek about two miles from the landing in Allegheny township in the county of Westmoreland.
