Pursuant to Contract with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Penn<sup>a</sup> dated Nov. first 1827 & the authority therein, the above tract of land bordered with green was survey<sup>d</sup> & calculated, by virtue of a warrant dated 28th Feby. 1774. granted to Conrad Gehrhart by the Proprietary Government, contain three hundred acres & ninety six perches & all<sup>s</sup> situate in Versailles township, Allegheny County.
