



The shaded lines in the above diagram represent the survey made to Thomas Morris on the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. The land called for by Morris warrant is found to lie North of the purchase of 1763 and within the purchase of 1784. The dotted lines together with the survey of Thomas Morris represent a survey made to Timothy Pickering upon a new purchase warrant No. 348 owned by Pickering and Company but not occupied by any one. The land is not claimed by any person under the title of Thomas Morris.
