



The above tract of land was surveyed to Charles McCoy on the 24th August 1787. By warrant of the 11th August 1786 and embraces the land as near as I could make out called for by John Vanderins Junr^r warrant. A survey of which I made on the 10th of May 1828 A return of which is here with enclosed. I am informed that the persons claiming under the title of John Vanderin Junr^r have long since given it up to Charles McCoy he having been in possession of the land under a title from the commonwealth for many years before any attempt was made to claim under Vanderins warrant. It not appearing ^{that} any survey had ever been ~~made~~ made thereon. The land is now in the occupancy of Benjamin Walker Junr^r and Thomas & Joseph Benkley and claimed by them under the title to Chas. McCoy which is patented.
