



In pursuance of a warrant granted to James Wright dated April 19<sup>th</sup> 1776 surveyed on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February 1829 the above described tract of land containing three hundred and nineteen acres eight perches and the allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c. Situate on the head spring of Charties landing creek about two miles from where Bradley claimed land in Allegheny township in the county of Westmoreland about 1 mile from James Whites improvement.
