



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day surveyed and located Warrant granted 3<sup>d</sup> May 1773 to Joseph McKee for 200as on the waters of Torris Creek including his improve<sup>t</sup> in Hamiltonbann township, on lands situate in Hamiltonbann (now Liberty) township Adams; and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
