



In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed application No. 5417 issued 1st April, 1769, to William Carson for 40 acres of land in Reading & Tyrone Townships, on lands situate in Reading Township, Adams County, to contain a small Improvement, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
