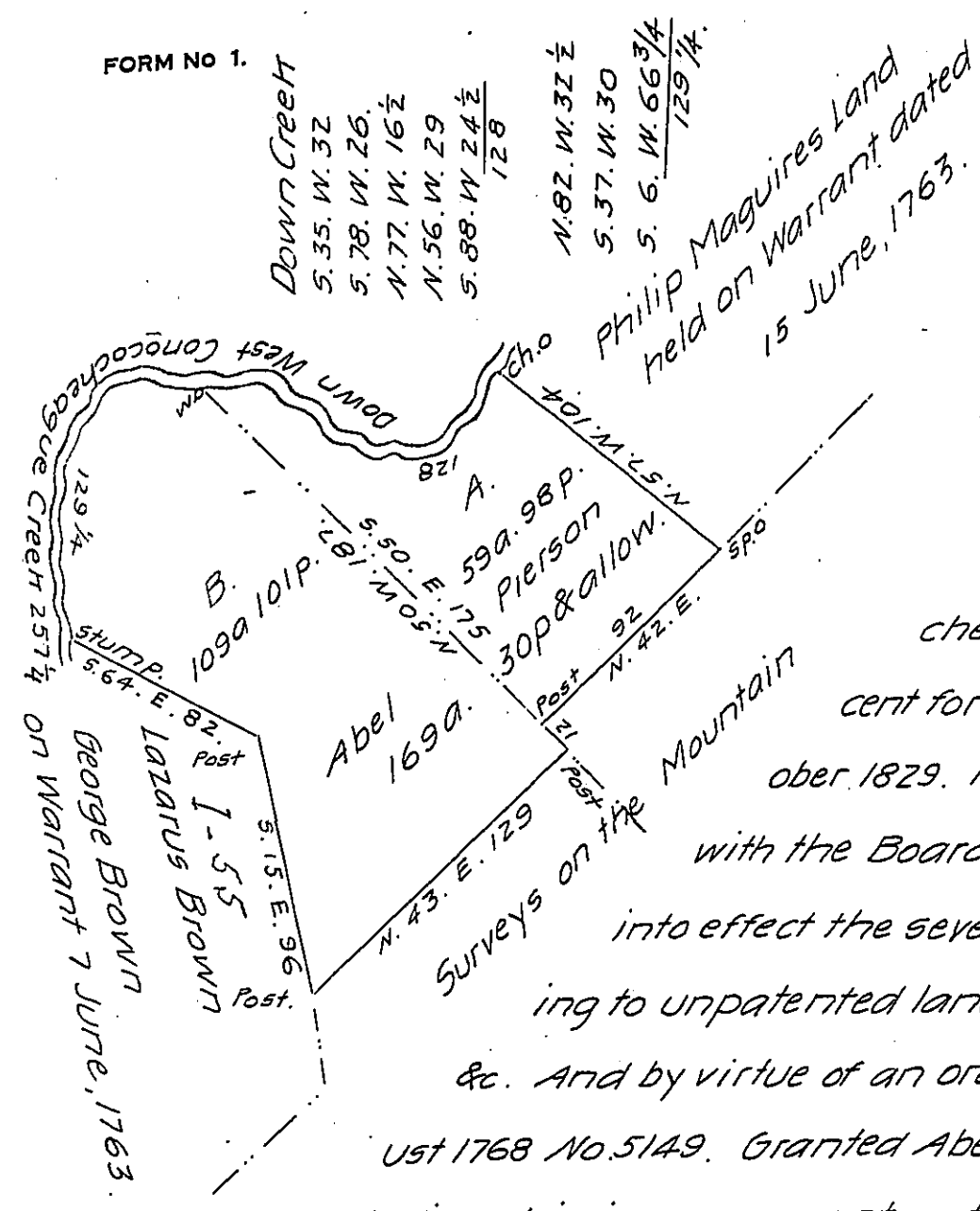


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Metal (formerly Fannet) Township Franklin County, containing one hundred & sixty nine acres and thirty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. located 30th October 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an order of survey dated 27 August 1768 No. 5149. Granted Abel Pierson for 300 acres

"Including his improvement on the south side of Conococheague Creek joining Philip Maguire, a mountain & George Brown in Fannet Township"

The figure marked A. of 590.98 p & al. is wholly the same as a tract survey'd 7 April 1769 on order to James Hervey dated 3d February 1768 No 4731 & held by John Patterson under said title. The figure B, of 1090.101 ps & al. is wholly the same as a tract. Survey'd 5 May 1789 on warrant to Daniel Henderson dated 17 October 1787 & held by James Style under said title. Note. Although the above land is fairly located by Piersons order, yet there appears no evidence of possession in him or of any person claiming under him
