Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted Peter Ringleman dated February 3d 1814 and is now owned by Henry Lightner and Henry Titzel Esqr. Situate in Tyrone Township Perry County and contains within the yellow lines two hundred seventy one acres 11 perches & allowance of Six Pr. Cent. Surveyed March 17th, 1828. Order for 3000, granted John Dunbar dated July 19th, 1768, No. 5111. Pr. Wm. Wilson. D.S. Gabriel Hiester Esqr. S. G. Wm. Power, Pat'd, Jno Creigh, not ret'd, Ringleman not Pat'd.
