



Application-5466. 9th May 1769 granted to John Cox for 50 acres in Manheim Township.

In pursuance of the several acts of assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes. I have this day surveyed and located Application-5466 granted 9th May 1769 to John Cox for 50 acres in Manheim Township, on lands situate in Manheim Township aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand. November 29th, 1837
